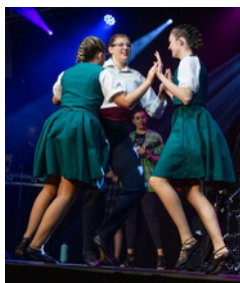

Food Ingredients

Haggis Beef liver, suet, pork, steel oats, salt, pepper, nutmeg, thyme, onion

Sausage Rolls Pork, beef, potato binder, flour, salt, butter

Scotch Pies Flour, salt, butter, egg, beef, onion, pepper, nutmeg, beef broth, corn starch

Scotch Eggs hard-boiled eggs, pork, seasoning, salt, mustard, bread crumbs

Veggie Pies Pastry (flour, salt, vegetable shortening), Filling: peas, carrots, potatoes, cream of celery soup, (celery, corn, canola oil, modified corn starch, flour, cream, salt, soy protein concentrate, sugar, yeast extract, spice, onion powder, flavour)

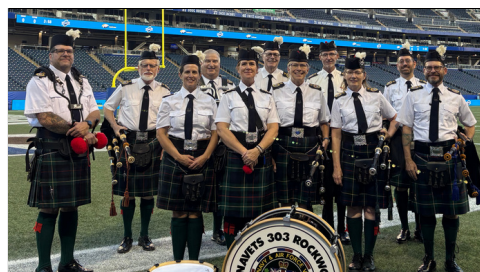

In Café 13, you can consult the Manitoba Genealogical Society about tracing your family history. Inquire about bagpiping from the Prairie Pipe Band Association or Highland dancing lessons through the Manitoba Highland Dancers' Association. Find out about the Manitoba Highland Gathering and watch the Royal Scottish Country Dancers' Society in action. Learn about the Scottish settlers and all their contributions to our province with the Manitoba Living History Society. There are several groups offering information about ways to stay involved with Scottish culture throughout the year.



Our Hint of Heather Gift Shop is also in the same room. And don't leave without visiting the Scotch Glen on the patio for the history, varieties and distilling of Scotch Whisky.
